



TF-CBT Training for CACs in the Carolinas

The Children's Advocacy Centers of North Carolina and the South Carolina Network of Children's Advocacy Centers are collaborating on a project to provide Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT) training to Children's Advocacy Center associated therapists in North Carolina and South Carolina. **A portion of this training will focus on the delivery of TF-CBT via a telehealth model.**

What is Required

TF-CBT is the most well-supported, evidence-based treatment for children/youth and their caregivers who have experienced or been exposed to abuse, violence, or other potentially traumatic events, and who have clinically significant problems as a result. Participating clinicians will learn to deliver TF-CBT with high clinical competence and adherence to the treatment model from nationally approved TF-CBT trainers. Clinicians will also learn proven techniques for delivery of TF-CBT via a telehealth model. This training program will consist of multiple training activities, components, and modalities, including:

01. **Self-directed readings and the online webcourse, TF-CBTWeb 2.0**
02. **2 TF-CBT Learning Sessions - each will be 3 half days, via a virtual platform.**
03. **1 half day training session on delivery of TF-CBT via telehealth**
04. **14 one-hour clinical case consultation calls over 7 months on TF-CBT training cases**
05. **Collection and use of clinical assessment, fidelity, service delivery, and implementation tools and metrics.**

When and Where

All learning sessions will be conducted in a virtual format from 9am-2pm each **days of training** listed below.

- May 17, 2021 - Registration opens
- September 2021 - Pre-work learning completed
- **October 6-8, 2021 - TFCBT Learning Session 1**
- **October 28, 2021 - Telehealth Delivery Session**
- **February 9-11, 2022 - TFCBT Learning Session 2**
- May 31, 2022 - All program work completed

Participants completing all training requirements will receive a certificate of completion from SCNCAC/CACNC and will have met the training and clinical consultation call requirements for National Certification in TF-CBT.
